LIST OF SAFETY ITEMS TO HAVE ON BOARD

As per Belgian law you must have following items on board:

- Radar reflector, black cone, black anchor ball
- Mist horn
- Navigation lights
- Mooring ropes (as long as your boat requires, and at least 1 rope of 20M long)
- anchor + line (as required by your boat weight
- necessary means to get the water out of your boat (bucket, pump, ...)
- necessary means to fix a small leak
- life buoy / life sling
- swimming ladder
- life lines / life harness per person / life jacket
- first aid kit
- updated navigation charts, tidal charts (on paper or digital)
- fire extinguisher
- local navigation zone rule book
- official boat papers (registration letter, radio documents, ...)
- pyrotechnics (3 & 2 chutes + smoke pot)
- 1 fixed magnetic compass & 1 hand bearing compass
- Fixed VHF, GPS, echo sounder, speedlog
- Binoculars & water resistant hand torchlight

By paying your membership fee you give a strong signal to the Class in general and more specifically to the board. The Half Ton Class is a story about you and us, and we write that story together!




















KYCN SITE MAP
